Dear Property Owner;

The City of Keizer along with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is addressing the needs of the citizens of the community, region and state to provide a safe and effective method for access to the newly opened Keizer Rapids Park along with addressing serious safety concerns for the citizens, transit service, freight and pedestrian traffic who share this roadway with the high school access. The project will consist of safety enhancements including a pedestrian corridor of 6' separated sidewalks and 5' bike lanes. Along the separated sidewalks will be a series of "water garden" stormwater infiltration areas on both sides of Chemawa Rd from River Rd to the Keizer Rapids Park. A traffic signal will also be added at Delight St and Chemawa Rd including a turn pocket at the McNary High School entrance and the remainder of Chemawa Rd will be (2) 11'6" travel lanes.

This is a federal, state and locally funded project with no cost impact to the property owners. One of the first parts of the project is to complete an accurate survey establishing existing right of way lines. ODOT survey crews will be working on or near your property to provide accurate data for the design team.
