As people see the yellow flashing light down by Alder it seems to slow traffic. How can we do the same for those coming near the roundabout by Keizer road or can we add one of the yellow flashing lights to Keizer road? Tammy or Jacqueline Will talk to the traffic safety/ Bikeways and pedestrians committee to see how this can be looked at for an option at the next meeting.

The folks from Claggett road were not able to attend but will update next month at the meeting. We will hear from them on the impact of what is going on with the speeding concerns.

Tammy covered the safe route to school walking map and shared the website information for those who need to have that access. The online group would like to follow the steps to become recognized by the safe route to school program. Tammy and Jacqueline will do what they can for that information and email that to everyone within the next 10 days.
