Traffic Safety Report by Martin at the Traffic, Streets, Bikes and Pedestrian Safety committee meeting:  
Bike lanes on Clearview are being parked in. Police reported that they have given tickets, but are short on man power. It was advised for neighbors to talk to neighbors. Other possible solutions: lower speed limits on the street. At Manbrin on our side, people are being considerate. On Alder, raised speed bumps at Brooks were suggested. BeeBe has the no parking signs, but would like to have more no parking around the corner to Arnold Street.

The minutes from Sept 2019, Jan. and Feb. 2020 (The months that we actually had a quorum.) were move for approval by Sherrie and seconded by Bob. Passed unanimously. Colleen will get them sent to Tracy. Sherrie will bring the May minutes next month.
