

AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT
FOR REPAINTING OF PAVEMENT MARKING LEGENDS

PARTIES: CITY OF KEIZER, an Oregon
municipal corporation (hereinafter "Owner")

HICKS STRIPING & CURBING, INC.,
an Oregon corporation (hereinafter "Contractor")

RECITALS:

- A. Owner and Contractor entered into that certain Contract for Repainting of Pavement Marking Legends on June 8, 2021 (hereinafter "Contract").
- B. The Contract ends on October 18, 2022 unless by written mutual agreement of the parties, it is extended
- C. Owner and Contractor desire to extend the Contract for one year to October 16, 2023.
- D. Contractor has requested that the contract sum for the extended year be amended.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

AGREEMENT:

1. Section 2 of the Contract shall be amended as follows:
 2. TIME OF COMPLETION. Upon full execution of the Contract and submittal of all required insurance documentation, the Contractor shall commence the work covered by this Contract on July 1, 2021 and shall coordinate this work with the Public Works Director and/or designee to assure completion of all aspects of the project relating to schools or school zones for the first year no later than September 1, 2021. The remainder of the work for the first year shall be completed between July 1, 2021 and October 18, 2021. Contractor shall commence the work covered by this Contract on July 1, 2022 to assure completion of all aspects of the project relating to schools or school zones for the second year no later than September 1, 2022. The remainder of the work for the second year shall be completed between July 1, 2022 and October 18, 2022.

Contractor shall commence the work covered by this Contract on July 1, 2023 to assure completion of all aspects of the project relating to schools or school zones for the third year no later than September 1, 2023. The remainder of the work for the third year shall be completed between July 1, 2023 and October 16, 2023. These timelines are subject to adjustments as provided for in the Contract Documents. **Time limits stated above are of the essence of this Contract.**

2. Section 6 of the Contract shall be amended as follows:

6. CONTRACT SUM. The Contract Sums are as described on the Contractor's Proposal attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein. Unless the Contract states otherwise, the actual sum payable to Contractor for the work shall be based on the Contractor's Proposal. For the third year of the Contract, the actual sum payable to Contractor for the work shall be based on the Contractor's Proposal for Year 2 (2022) plus ten percent (10%).


3. Except as specifically modified herein, all remaining terms, conditions, obligations and duties set forth in the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

4. Facsimile or electronic transmission of any signed original document, and retransmission of any signed facsimile or electronic transmission, shall be the same as delivery of an original. At the request of either party, the parties shall confirm facsimile or electronic transmitted signatures by signing an original document.
