**WELCOME TO NEW MEMBER DAVID LOUDEN:** Chair Busch welcomed Mr. Loudon who then shared information about himself with the committee.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** ~ Lisa Cejka moved for approval of the October 2020 Minutes. Lorene Moore seconded. Motion passed as follows: Busch, Becker, Cejka and Engles in favor with Moore and Loudon abstaining and one position vacant.

**PROJECTS/REPORTS**

**Informational Signage at Keizer School:** Complete.

**Informational Signage at Schoolhouse Square:** Bob Busch volunteered to take the project.

**Oral History:** Robert Becker reported that the audio of the Clyde and Dan Keizer interview is poor quality. He is working on improving it and will send it out when it is fixed. He has been contacted by a man from Walla Walla whose grandmother was a Keizer and who is doing a Keizer family history book. Tammy Wilde is working with him. This person will be the next oral history candidate.

**Facebook Page:** Bob Busch noted that the page is getting lots of visits.

**Willamette University:** Lisa Cejka shared a reply from the Archivist at Willamette University which stated that the original location was 10 miles north of Salem which would be outside of the Keizer city limits.

**Longitude 123:** Kathi Engles reported that she had visited with Richard Walsh who suggested that the latitude/longitude be painted on the water tower. Staff interjected that the cost would be prohibitive. Ms. Engles then suggested that a sign be developed and hung on the fence at the Little League Park. She indicated she would compile suggestions from the committee and have something for the next meeting.

**Willamette River Water Trail Designation for Wallace House Park:** Kathi Engles reported that she had tried unsuccessfully to reach Jim Taylor. Chair Busch gave her the correct phone number. Ms. Engles is hoping to have parks along the Willamette shown on the Willamette River Water Trail website maps.

**Neighborhood History/Origination of Street Names:** No report.

**Compilation of Keizer Memorials:** No report.

**History of Parks:** David Loudon indicated that he would research park histories.
