CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF KEIZER, STATE OF OREGON
Ordinance No. 83-00

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION; PROVIDING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES.

The City of Keizer ordains as follows:

Section 1

KEIZER PLANNING COMMISSION; COMPOSITION; TERMS AND VACANCIES.

- a. The Keizer Planning Commission is hereby created. The commission will have the powers and duties hereinafter set forth and such additional powers and duties as may be conferred on such commission by the constitution and laws of the State of Oregon, by the Charter of the City of Keizer or by Ordinances, Resolutions or orders of the City Council.
- b. The commission will consist of the City administrator as an ex-officio, non voting member and seven other members to be appointed by the City Council. No more than one voting member shall be engaged principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit as individuals, or be members of any partnership, or officers or employees of any corporation, that engages principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit. No more than one voting member shall be engaged in the same kind of occupation, business, trade or profession. No more than one member shall be a non-resident of the City of Keizer.
 - c. The term of office of the appointed members shall

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- d. The City Council shall fill any vacancy in the commission by appointment for the unexpired term of the predecessor in office. Prospective members of the commission may be required to qualify by submitting a written application and/or appearing before the city council for a personal interview. Before entering upon the duties of a planning commissioner, each commissioner shall take an oath or shall affirm support for the constitution and the laws of the United States and of the State of Oregon and that each commissioner will faithfully and impartially perform duties of that office.
- e. The members of the commission shall receive no compensation but shall be reimbursed for duly authorized expenses.

Section 2

ORGANIZATION

a. The commission shall elect a chairman and vice chairman, who shall be members appointed by the City

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- b. Four members appointed by the City Council shall at all times constitute a quorum.
- c. The commission shall meet at least once each month and the regular meeting place of the commission shall be the City Hall.
- d. The commission may make, establish and alter rules and regulations for its government and procedure consistent with the laws of the State of Oregon and with the charter and ordinances of the City of Keizer. Before any rules, amendments or deletions become effective, the commission must submit them to the City Council for approval.

Section 3

ANNUAL REPORT TO COUNCIL

The commission shall on or before the first day of October each year make and file with the City Council a report of all transactions of the commission for the preceding fiscal year.

Section 4

POWERS AND DUTIES

Except as otherwise provided by the City Council, the city planning commission may:

- a. Recommend and make suggestions to the council and to other public authorities concerning:
 - A. The laying out, widening, extending and locating

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congestion:

- Betterment of housing and sanitation conditions;
- Establishment of district for limiting the use, height, area, bulk and other characteristics of buildings and structures related to land development:
- D. Protection and assurance of access to incident solar radiation: and
- Protection and assurance of access to wind for potential future electrical generation or mechanical application.
- Recommend to the council and other public authorities plans for regulating the future growth, development and beautification of the city in respect to its public and private buildings and works, streets, parks, grounds and vacant lots, and plans consistent with future growth and development of the city in order to secure to the city and its inhabitants sanitation, proper service of public utilities, including appropriate public incentives for overall energy conservation and harbor, shipping and transportation facilities.
- Recommend to the council and other public authorities plans for promotion, development and regulation of industrial and economic needs of the community in respect to industrial pursuits.
- d. Promote the advantage and opportunities of the city and availability of real estate within the city for development.

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- e. Encourage economic development within the
- f. Make economic surveys of present and potential commercial and industrial needs of the city.
- g. Study needs of local industries with a view to strengthening and developing them and stabilizing employment conditions.
- h. Do and perform all other acts and things necessary or proper to carry out the provisions of ORS 227.010 to 227.170, 227.175 and 227.180.
- i. Study and propose such measures as are advisable for promotion of the public interest, health, morals, safety, comfort, convenience and welfare of the city and of the area within six miles thereof, except where by law such powers and duites devolve upon some other public body as to the area outside the city.
 - j. For the purposes of this section:
- (a) "Incident solar radiation" means solar energy falling upon a given surface area.
- (b) "Wind" means the natural movement of air at an annual average speed measured at a height of 10 meters of at least eight miles per hour.
