**Informational Signage at Keizer School:** Robert Becker reported that the Board approved the signage and suggested that it be put on a free standing sign to be placed in front of the museum so that people can see it as they walk in. He will find out the cost and report back.

**Oral History:** Robert Becker reported that he had tried to do a 'virtual' interview with Kyle Keizer who resides in The Dalles, but was unsuccessful. He is exploring other options.

**Facebook Page:** Discussion took place on how to become an administrator on the page. Robert Becker will research this.

**Willamette University:** Lisa Cejka volunteered to take on this project.

**Longitude 123:** Kathi Engles suggested that an obelisk be placed at the Little League Park with each surface facing the direction of a compass. She asked for input from the committee as to what should go on it.

**Willamette River Water Trail Designation for Wallace House Park:** Kathi Engles received direction on how to find out when the meetings are and will follow up.

**Neighborhood History/Origination of Street Names:** No report.

**Map of Little Libraries:** Bob Busch reported that there are five registered Little Libraries and ten unregistered ones. Lisa Cejka volunteered to get the addresses of the ones in her neighborhood. Staff will add them to the Points of Interest Map and have them added to the interactive map that is posted on the City website.
