Project Description: Describe the project for which the matching grant funds are requested including a description of labor and materials needed for completion of the project, a cost estimate for project completion if available, impact on the community, involvement of the organization itself and its volunteers. <i>Additional documentation may be attached to email that displays when "Submit" button is pressed.</i> With the seven volunteers we will wash the greenhouse with soap and water. Then move the greenhouse off its's original foundation so that it can be redone. First we will take out the old wooden frame and replace it with new pressure treated 4 x 2 x 10 cut to the apporperite length. Next when the new frame put together and put back where the old one was we will dig down about 3.5 inches. After that half an inch of gravel will be put in (leveled and compacted), then the brick will be laid out. Finally the cleaned greenhouse will be put back on to it's new foundation. All the material cost about or equal to 53.08, I need four 4 x 2 x 10 pressure treated wood which cost about 10.77 and 3 inch screws which are about 10.00 .	
*Successful applicants will be expected to follow all applicable city/state requirements/laws. *Grant recipients will be required to reapply for funds if the project is not completed by the agreed deadline.
