#### Good News!

The City of Keizer Utility Billing Department has a new program, which makes paying your water/sewer/storm water bill easy. It's called **Auto-Pay**, and it's easy because it's automatic.

Auto-Pay offers these benefits:

#### CONVENIENCE:

When you use **Auto-Pay**, your water/sewer/storm water bill is paid automatically through your bank.

#### HASSLE FREE:

With **Auto-Pay**, you'll have one less check to write. You won't have to stop by the post office, drop box, or drop off your payment at City Hall.

#### SAVES MONEY:

Auto-Pay is a free service that will save you and the City time and money. Any water/sewer/storm water customer whose account is not delinquent can apply. In addition, you won't need stamps and envelopes to pay your bill.

With **Auto-Pay**, you maintain control of your payments. You will still receive a regular water/sewer/storm water bill in the mail. However, instead of writing a check, addressing an envelope, and paying for postage, your bank pays the bill straight from your bank account. You will still have plenty of time to review the bill, and call us with any questions before the payment is due.

#### HOW WILL YOU KNOW THE BILL IS BEING PAID?

Continue to pay the bill as always until you receive a bill imprinted with **"AUTOMATIC PAY."** This indicates the bill is being paid through your bank account.

## Q. How does Auto Pay work?

Α. Auto-Pay is an payment automatic program for vour water/sewer/storm water bill. You still receive a bill. Instead of mailing your payment your bank withdraws the funds from either your checking or savings account.

# Q. When are payments made?

**A.** Payments are made on or about the 15<sup>th</sup> of the same month; you receive your bill (approximately every 60 days). Sorry we cannot adjust this date.

#### Q. Can I cancel the program if it doesn't work for me?

**A.** Yes; simply notify the City of Keizer Utility Billing Department and your bank **in writing**. <u>Be sure to allow</u> <u>2 weeks for your request to</u> <u>be processed</u>.
