

Donating to Keizer's Parks

Keizer encourages donations and volunteer efforts to improve our public parks. To truly be a benefit such contributions need to be carefully planned, well constructed, and maintained to a standard acceptable to the community. The City wants to encourage donations while managing aesthetic impacts and mitigating on-going maintenance costs.

Donations should be coordinated with the Public Works Department who manages our parks. Donations helping to accomplish improvements identified in our parks master plan are most welcome; many of these are listed below with their approximate cost. Financial donations, either for a specific purpose or unrestricted are encouraged as they enable city staff to purchase and install improvements consistent with city standards. Other donations are also encouraged but are reviewed by the Department to assure they are consistent with City policies and standards.

Trees – City standards require specific species, size, and planting schedule to improve survivability, aesthetics and maintenance; **Benches; Drinking Fountains; Picnic Tables; Bicycle Racks/Lockers; Shelters, Skate Parks, BMX Facilities, Park Land** – the sky is the limit. Keizer encourages you to think big while working out the details with city staff. Past significant contributions to the on-going quality of our community have been through voluntary contributions from individuals, organizations, and businesses.

Plaques acknowledging donors or a memorial are possible when they do not detract from the quality of the visitor's experience, meet city standards, and are appropriate.
